

RECRUITMENT OF DIPLOMA TRAINEES FOR BRBCL, KBUNL AND NPGCL

Frequently Asked Questions – Admit Card & Examination

SI No	Question	Reply
1.	Date/Day and Time of Examination	Tentative Exam Date: 14 th /15 th June, 2018 (Thursday/Friday) Exam timings will be notified in the Admit Card.
2.	When will I get my admit card?	Candidates will be informed through E-mail and SMS for downloading the admit card. You can log onto the http://dtjvrecruitment.net online application portal with your registered User name and Password for downloading the admit card. Admit cards will not be sent by post.
3.	What will be the duration & Scheme of Examination	Duration of computer based examination is 2 hours (one sitting). The question paper will consist of two parts- Part-I will be Knowledge Test and will consist of 70 multiple-choice questions of the relevant disciplines as advertised. Part-II will be Aptitude Test and will consist of 50 multiple-choice questions on English, Quantitative aptitude & Reasoning. Each question will carry 1 mark and 1/4 th mark will be deducted for each wrong answer. The question paper will be bilingual i.e. in English and Hindi only.
4.	Details mentioned in the Admit Card (Name, DOB, Category) vary from what I have mentioned in the application form. Can it be changed?	If the details printed on the e-admit card, are different/varies from the details provided by the candidates during the registration of online application, such candidates are advised to personally report, one day before the conduct of examination at the ' Facilitation Centre ' from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm with 2 passport size photographs along with documentary evidence/proof so that necessary corrections are made. The address of the 'Facilitation Centre' will be made available at http://dtjvrecruitment.net website. <i>Modifications / corrections are not possible at this stage.</i>
5.	Photograph in the admit card is not clear	Bring Two recent colored passport size photographs same as uploaded at the time of online registration and submit the same to the Invigilator for further action.
6.	Photograph uploaded in place of signature and vice versa	Bring Two recent colored passport size photographs same as uploaded at the time of online registration and submit to the invigilator for further action.
7.	I haven't received my User id & password, what should I do?	You must have received e-mail for username & password after successful registration on online application portal. If you are not able to retrieve our mail kindly check your spam or other folders. If you don't remember your password, kindly click on forget password. You will receive a password reset link on your registered e-mail id. 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8.	I have applied twice, which form will be accepted.	As per advertisement, you can appear only in one discipline. In case of multiple applications, last application will only be considered. You must surrender your admit card at the examination centre on the exam day, if received more than one.
9.	What will be the syllabus and pattern of questions	For syllabus, you have to visit http://dtjvrecruitment.net online application portal.
10.	Mock test link required.	Mock Test Link is available at http://dtjvrecruitment.net online application portal.
11.	Is there any negative marking	There is 1/4 th mark will be deducted for each wrong answer.
12.	What are the valid ID proof that I can bring along with admit card at exam centre?	One Original Govt. issued ID proof (<i>not photocopy or scanned copy</i>) i.e. Voter Identity Card, Driving License, PAN Card, Passport or Aadhar Card.
13.	I am unable to download my Admit Card, whom should I contact?	Only those candidates who have successfully submitted their application will be able to download their admit card. The Admit Card needs to be directly downloaded from the http://dtjvrecruitment.net online application portal using your registered Username and Password The admit card will not be mailed to your postal address. If you are unable to view your Admit Card post log in, refer to the help desk details given below. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Toll free: 18002669411(Toll Free) • Email: bkn.helpdesk2018@gmail.com If you are still not able to download your admit card then you are advised to personally report, one day before the conduct of examination at the 'Facilitation Centre' from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm with 2 passport size photographs along with documentary evidence/proof of successful submission of application, so that a fresh admit card is issued against valid candidature accordingly. The address of the 'Facilitation Centre' will be made available at online login link from http://dtjvrecruitment.net No TA/DA will be paid to any candidate for appearing in the Online examination.
14.	I have made a mistake in the application (DOB/Gender/Email ID/Name/Parents Name/Pin code/Roll no/ % / Marks/Documents/Photo & Signature/Work Experience) while registering. Can this be Rectified?	Once the application is submitted successfully, no modifications are allowed at this stage. Photo/ID Proof/ Signature/DOB Certificate/Caste Certificate once uploaded cannot be changed.

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15.	What items are not permitted to be brought inside the examination venue?	<p>One E-Admit Card, one ID Proof in original and 1-2 pens are permitted to be carried inside the examination centre.</p> <p>Candidates are not allowed to bring any electronic gadgets such as Cell phone, Calculator, Bluetooth, Electronic diaries or any other electronic device with memory or Listening devices and recording or photographic devices, wrist watches, wrist watch phones, pagers, pen scanners or multimedia devices or any other communication devices even in switch Off mode including hand bags, ornaments, documents/papers inside the examination room/hall.</p> <p>BRBCL/KUBNL/NPGCL will not make any provision to keep them in safe custody and candidates themselves are responsible for safety of their belongings.</p>
16.	Late coming allowed or not	<p>You are required to reach examination centre 90 minutes before the scheduled time of conduct of examination, so that entry formalities i.e. Biometric Registration by capturing thumb impression, Webcam Photograph, Physical Frisking, Photo-matching with ID Proof etc can be done smoothly. For Bio-metric registration of the candidate, it is advised not to apply any external materials on their hands/foot like mehendi, ink etc.</p> <p>Candidates are strictly advised to not apply/ have applied mehendi on their hands on the day of the test.</p> <p>Test Centre gate will be closed 30 minutes prior of the exam hours. In any case, the candidates will not be permitted to enter the venue of the examination centre after the prescribed gate closing time.</p>
17.	Request for change of exam city/centre/shift.	No change in exam city/centre/shift will be entertained.
18.	Will the traveling allowance (TA) be provided for going to the examination center?	<p>As indicated in Advertisement No. 02/2018/BRBCL/KBUNL/NPGCL, No TA/DA is admissible.</p> <p>Candidates have to appear for Computer Based Test at his/her own expenses.</p>
19.	Am I allowed to leave the examination hall during the test?	NO. Candidates will NOT be allowed to leave the examination hall for any reason during the scheduled time of test. Candidates are allowed to leave their respective labs only after the closure examination.
20.	I want to know the reason for rejection of my application form at this stage.	Non-submission of application in all respects/Non Receipt of Fee/Non-uploading of documents etc.
21.	The examination city/centre has not been allotted as per my choice – why?	On account of large number of candidates, it has become difficult to accommodate at the choice of city/centre.
